- Research:
 - Demographics

 - Food, housing and job insecurity
- Marketing/Communications:

- Education
 - Educational oversight and program development
- Fundraising
- Visual, Music, Storytelling and Performing Arts

- Food needs for festivals and for food insecurity
- Connect with various minority and immigrant/refugee groups including Indigenous peoples in Clinton
- Make certain materials and content created are accessible including compliance with WCAG to ensure access to those with visual and other limitations
