March 24, 2021

Members Present: Carrie Allen, Moe Bean and Paul Egan in attendance. Meeting called to order at 6:04 pm.

Minutes Approved Minutes were reviewed from February 2021. Carrie moved to accept minutes Paul seconded and minutes were approved.

Bike Giveaway/Swap Safety Day Event The event is scheduled for Saturday April 17 from 10 am until 2 pm. It will be held at behind the Police Station. Clinton PD will provide a car child seat safety installation demonstration. Clinton PD bike officers will provide a bike safety rodeo. The event will be rain or shine and some shelter is available. Clinton PD will provide two tables for BPAC materials. Carrie will investigate printing of safety bike coloring book pages and also stickers for the back of pamphlets with BPAC FaceBook page and if possible, a 2D barcode to help raise awareness of us and our cause. Bike safety pamphlets and Bike Safety Check Bookmarks will be available on our table. Bikes will be provided for those who have outgrown or need a bike. Families Helping Families will be purchasing bike helmets from Bikes For Kids at cost and distributing them with bicycles at the event.

Greenway Update Carrie reported that Jennie (chairperson of BPAC in Madison and co-chair of the Shoreline Greenway) reports that Madison is having their Route 1 Corridor Study to see how much impact a bike trail will have passing through in front of Clam Castle vs. going through the “boneyard” maintenance are of the Hammonassett property.

Bike Repair Stations update The bike repair station to be located at the new Clinton Train Station will be installed in the sheltered bike rack area. The contractor has been given installation instructions for the repair station and will be installing it in November. The “first choice” location for the additional bike repair station has been approved for Clinton Town Beach. Bo Potter will meet with Carrie and Paul on site to pick an installation spot.

Fund Raising Event for 2021 Due to the COVID 19 situation and in an abundance of caution, it was decided not to attempt a fundraising event this year.

Motion to adjourn was made and seconded. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 pm.
