2. Review and Discussion re: Meal Charging Policy

M. O'Donnell shared the proposed new policy as a result of changes to statute that requires boards of education to outline procedures for collecting unpaid meal charges. She stated that meal debts will need to be absorbed by the district's operating budget at the end of the school year if a student has an outstanding balance. The subcommittee discussed the potential issues regarding trying to collect outstanding balances. This policy will be on the next agenda of the Policy Subcommittee for review.
