APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

MARINA ASSIGNMENTS

Art Navarro has been assigned to Slip A13 since 2012.

Albert Penta has been assigned to A15. He has not had a boat in the water for a couple of years. Navarro would like to use A15 when Penta's boat is not there. Tim Wahl, the former Dock Master had given Navarro permission to be in A15 for 2018 season. Penta does not plan to put his boat in this season. Navarro will stay in A15 for 2019 season. Navarro would like a port side slip because his boat opening door is on the port side.

The Commission will do what it can to accommodate slip holders. Navarro requests assignment to A12, A16 or A19. The Commission has full discretion to assign slips.

DOCKMASTER REPORT

The purchase of a plaque for Tim Wahl was discussed and it will be placed at the marina office.

B dock power is being worked on by Acorn Bernier Electricians.

D Dock water line snapped. DPW is repairing it.

Ice box rentals: waiting to hear back from suppliers.

\$9273 has been deposited in the past month. Ramp fees were \$6720; transient fees were \$2553. Total collected this season is \$10,907.

HARBOR MASTER REPORT

The Town has discussed turning the trailer parking area into car only parking. The Commission is requesting that the parking remain for trailers. Dahlgren will represent the Commission at the parking meeting with the Town.
