Special Meeting Minutes

Adams called the meeting to order at 6:27 pm.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Iverson made a motion to accept the meeting minutes of May 13, 2021, seconded by Dahlgren. The motion was accepted and the minutes approved.

HARBOR MANAGEMENT PLAN

Adams discussed the grant that the Town applied for in 2019. The State had not acted on it in light of COVID. The State recently requested information from the Town which the Town supplied. Since then, the Town has not received any update on the progress from the State.

MOORING APPLICATION

The Harbor Master, Wayne Church received a request from a resident to put in a mooring. Church advised Adams of the request and inquired about the HMC's decision about fees. There was some discussion about a mooring policy – mooring field, fees, registration, an interim transitional period to implement it. The policy will need approval from the Town Council to enforce it.

KAYAK RACK

Adams has not been able to contact the Eagle Scout for a progress update. It's unclear whether she will complete the project.

DOCK MASTER REPORT

The ramp passes have been relatively slow due to poor weather in May and early June. There have been many complaints about the condition of the ramp. Two boats that couldn't stay on D dock because of the faulty piling have been moved to the ends of the docks. Has been monitoring the depth in the marina in different locations. There have been cars in the trailer only parking; the staff dealt with them.
