**Regular Meeting Minutes**

Adams called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

**APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING**

Iverson made a motion to accept the Special meeting minutes of June 17, 2021, seconded by Dahlgren. The motion was accepted and the minutes approved.

**MOORING APPLICATIONS**

There was some discussion about a mooring policy. The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP), CT General Statutes Title 22a – 113r requires that the Harbor Management Commission establish a plan for moorings within its Harbor Management Plan. There may be fees associated with said moorings. The HMC has not yet approved a fee. There was a lengthy discussion about how to implement the policy. It was suggested that a public notice go in the paper to advise those with moorings that they will have to be identified and registered with the Town. The policy will need approval from the Town Council to enforce it.

**KAYAK RACK**

Adams has not been able to contact the Eagle Scout. Church offers to inquire about her with his contact at the Scouts.

**HARBOR MANAGEMENT PLAN**

The Town has not received any new information about the SHIPP grant for \$40,000.

**DOCK MASTER**

A Dock is currently without power.

DPW is aware and has alerted the Electrician

Two boats that had been assigned to D Dock are currently being accommodated at the ends of A Dock and C Dock. Markovics will approach them about the possibility of not being able to reassign next season.

Cart is still needed.

Brief discussion about the HMC Budget included in DPW's.

The Fire Dept. has requested access to the end of B dock; it was built with ability to use in emergencies to off load.

A grant from the CT Port Authority for \$110,000 is currently unused. There was a brief discussion about the conditions associated with the grant.

**HARBOR MASTER**

There were a couple of buoys were off position.

Church notified Coast Guard. He checked them yesterday and they seem to have been corrected.

Church will check with Riverside Basin about possibly moving #10, 11 and 12 to widen channel.

ADJOURN

Motion to adjourn was made by Iverson. Seconded by Dahlgren. The motion was accepted and the meeting was adjourned at 7:35pm.
