Ground Coverage Calculation Sheet

NOTES:

1. Decks that are measured more than 6' in height from the ground to the top of the deck floor are not considered ground coverage.
2. Driveways, patios and sidewalks made of pervious materials do not count towards ground coverage.
3. For round pools or other round structures, the square footage is calculated: 3.14 x the radius squared (1/2 the diameter of the pool multiplied by itself). I.e. the square footage of a pool with a diameter of 20' would be calculated as: 3.14 x (10x10) = 314 sq. ft.
4. The acreage for your lot is on the assessor's field card at the bottom of the form.
